Mr. Harris mentioned the new statute that states that if an applicant has been licensed in another state for five years then they qualify for licensure in Florida and that board has also had discussion about their general education requirements in relation to licensure.

Mr. Harris explained the basis for the denial. The basis for denial is education. Mr. Joshi lacks nine hours of general education. Mr. Joshi submitted an Election of Rights form requesting an informal hearing.

Mr. Harris discussed the board's position on the general education requirements based on past board discussions and that the rule will be under development based on this. Discussion followed.

Upon motion by Ms. Ramsey, seconded by Ms. Myers, to vacate the Notice of Intent to Deny and approve the application, the motion passed.

#2. Deepa Modi

Mr. Harris explained the basis for the denial. The basis for denial is education. Ms. Modi lacks four hours of general education. Ms. Modi submitted an Election of Rights form requesting an informal hearing.

Mr. Harris discussed the board's position on the general education requirements based on past board discussions and that the rule will be under development based on this. Discussion followed.

Upon motion by Ms. Ramsey, seconded by Ms. Myers, to vacate the Notice of Intent to Deny and approve the application, the motion passed.

The charges relate to violation of Section 471.033(1)(a), F.S. - Violating any provision of s.455.227(1) and Section 471.033(1)(d), F.S. - Being convicted or found guilty of, or entering a plea of nolo contendere to, regardless of adjudication, a crime in any jurisdiction which directly relates to the practice of engineering or the ability to practice engineering

The Probable Cause Panel recommendation was an administrative complaint, administrative fine of \$ 1,000.00, administrative costs of \$83.85, reprimand, and two years' probation.

The Settlement Stipulation is the same as the PCP recommendation.

Mr. Rimes outlined the facts of the case. The charges relate to violation of Section 471.033(1)(a), F.S. - Violating . . . any other provision of this chapter or rule of the board or department. Rule 61G15-19.001(6)(s), F.A.C.: Renewing or reactivating a license without completion of Continuing Education (CE) hours.

Probable Cause was found on January 10, 2024, on the issue of Respondent. An Administrative Complaint was authorized and filed on January 22, 2024. A signed Election of Rights requesting an Informal hearing was returned to the FBPE office February 26, 2024.

A Statement of Undisputed Material Facts was sent to Respondent on February 29, 2024. No response to the Statement of Undisputed Material Facts was received. A Request for Admission went out to Respondent on September 20, 2024. A response to the Request for Admissions was received on October 21, 2024. Respondent admitted to all of the Request for Admissions.

The Probable Cause Panel recommendation was an administrative complaint, administrative fine of \$1,000.00, administrative costs of \$144.30, reprimand, and appearance before the board to discuss how this situation occurred, what improvements and quality control measures will be implemented to prevent this circumstance from occurring in the future.

Upon motion by Mr. Gonzalez, seconded by Ms. Myers, that the respondent was properly served with the administrative complaint and filed an election of rights electing a Chapter 120.57(2) hearing not involving disputed issue of material facts, to convene such hearing, to accept the Statement of Undisputed Material Facts presented as the Board's findings of fact, to accept the entire investigative file of the case including the supplemental materials into evidence, to adopt the allegations in the administrative complaint as the Board's conclusions of law, and to find a violation of the practice act upon which discipline may be imposed, the motion passed.

Upon motion by Mr. Gonzalez, seconded by Ms. Myers, to accept the PCP recommendation but without the board appearance, the motion passed.

Probable Cause was found on May 08, 2024, and an Administrative Complaint was authorized. The Administrative Complaint was filed with the Department of Business and Professional Regulation ("DBPR") on May 20, 2024.

This case was presented to the Probable Cause Panel due to Mr. Hees's opinion. The Panel was asked to look at the project documents and Mr. Hees's opinion and to provide direction on how to move forward with this case. The PCP recommended that the 18-month review be waived and early termination of probation. A request for early termination was received on November 12, 2024.

The Respondent, Mr. Simmons, completed his study guide November 17, 2023, and paid his fine and costs on November 15, 2023. His P&E course was due October 17, 2024, and his 6-month project review was due April 17, 2024, and the 18-month project review is due April 17, 2025. The Respondent, Mr. Simmons has a P&E course that was due October 17, 2024, which is one month out of compliance and the 6-month project review which is seven months out of compliance. The Respondent sent in a letter requesting an extension to complete the P&E course and his project reviews. This case is being presented to the Board, for consideration of Mr. Simmons request for extension of the terms of the Final Order.
