F. Discussion on Location and Venue of In-Person Board Meetings

Mr. Forehand inquired about the location and venue of future in-person meetings. The Board then engaged in a broader discussion regarding potential changes to meeting locations.

Mr. Forehand suggested exploring venues to better accommodate Board members traveling from other regions of the state.

Ms. Raybon and Ms. Rebecca Sammons outlined constraints related to state guidelines, including per diem limitations and caps on hotel expenditures, which make it challenging to secure accommodations and meals at approved government rates.

Ms. Sammons reported that she has begun researching potential venues in Orlando and Tampa for a 2027 meeting and has contacted local convention and visitors bureaus for assistance in identifying suitable options.

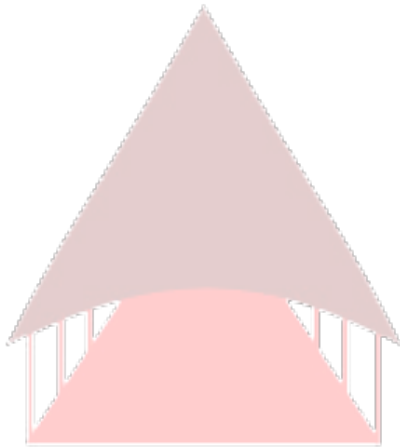
